## Saint or sinner?

LIPSTICK guru Poppy King has created 10 new shades in a range called Lipstick Queen Saints or Sinners, £15, available at Space NK.

Saintly souls will love the Saints range, which is sheer and gives a hint of colour, whereas the Sinners are decadent and rich in pigment. Colours range from pinks and berries to nudes and coral.

Follow her advice on how to wear your lippy:

### How do I know what suits me?

Trust what you see in the mirror when you try a colour. A lipstick shade that suits you will make skin, eyes and complexion look brighter and more alive. If the shade is wrong, you will look dull and drained.

### Should I use a liner?

If you like lip liner, use one that is slightly lighter than the shade of your lipstick, so that it doesn't look too harsh. Another tip is to

use a little concealer around the outside of the lips to make the edge more defined. Simply apply it before your lipstick.

### How do I stop lipstick from bleeding or moving?

If lipstick has a tendency to do this, then use a concealer around the outside of the lips.

### Can I wear red or bold colours?

The answer is simply yes. Everyone can wear bolder colours if they are prepared to make a statement. However, if you are feeling unsure, try a red in a sheer version first rather than full strength. Also, opt for minimal eye make up (just a little mascara and liner and very neutral shadow). That way you will not look overdone.

### What is the best colour to go with everything?

Any colour that is not too far removed from your own lip tone. Berry-coloured and plum tones tend to suit everyone.
